





HIGA: KNOW YOUR AWARD In-House Training

The HIGA: Know Your Award course provides attendees with the information they need to understand the provisions of the HIGA, and to ensure that they make the best decisions for the business's wage bill.

COURSE CONTENT

- Award coverage when an Award covers a particular employee position versus when an employee position is genuinely (and legally) an award-free position
- Types of employment the three types of employment allowable under the HIGA and how to confidently make the best use of each type. In this session the new part-time provisions which took effect from 1/1/18 are examined in detail
- Award entitlements the main entitlements to be aware of that can significantly impact on a wages bill, including:
 - Weekend penalty rates
 - Late work and Early work allowances
 - o Overtime for permanent and casual employees and when it applies
 - Meal breaks: when they need to be taken and the penalties for not providing a meal break
 - The various allowances that can apply to employees
- The National Employment Standards in the Fair Work Act 2009 and how it interacts with HIGA leave entitlements
- The interaction of Enterprise Agreements with the HIGA with respect to base wages
- Guarding against wages theft and getting the most out of rostering practices.

In addition, the QHA's presenter will discuss the most common HIGA interpretation questions and answers.
