

Stage 3 Easing of COVID-19 restrictions

Dear licensee

The Queensland Chief Health Officer's [Direction on Business, Activities and Undertakings](#) has been updated to reinstate the restriction for businesses to ensure all dining and drinking is for seated patrons and provide clarity for event organisers. This came into effect yesterday (24 July 2020).

Under this direction these venues can only provide food and drink for seated patrons:

- pubs, licensed clubs, RSL clubs, function centres, bars, wineries, distilleries and microbreweries and licensed premises in hotels
- Community facilities (such as community centres and halls, recreation centres, youth centres, community clubs, PCYCs)
- Casinos, gaming or gambling venues including wagering outlets that are open to, and accessible by, members of the public.
